The Fire Investigation: Practical Application and Hands on Experience Course is designed to give new investigators the basic skills needed to conduct thorough fire origin and cause investigations and provide practical experience at actual fire scenes.

This tested training introduces students to common terminology used in fire investigation, accepted principles and methods of NFPA 921 (2024), and covers seven of sixteen subjects within NFPA 1033 (2022): fire science, fire dynamics, fire investigation, fire analysis, fire investigation methodology, fire investigation technology, and evidence documentation, collection, and preservation.
